# THIRST FOR KNOWLEDGE

## 10 STUDENTS TRAIN IN BAKING AT MANDARIN ORIENTAL

The Tourism and Hospitality Management Division (THM) partnered with the School of the Oriental Hotel Apprenticeship Programme (OHAP) and came up with a month-long professional education program that trained 10 MUIC students.
