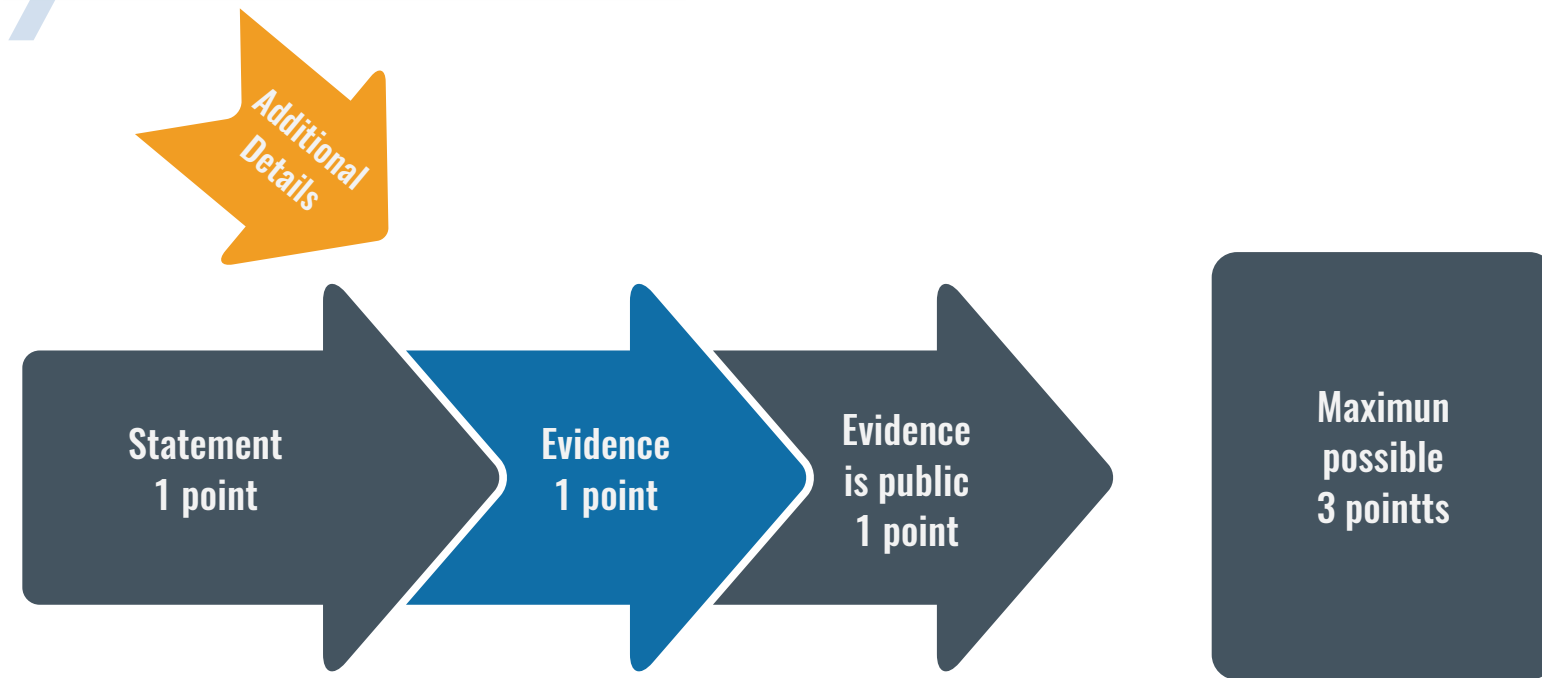
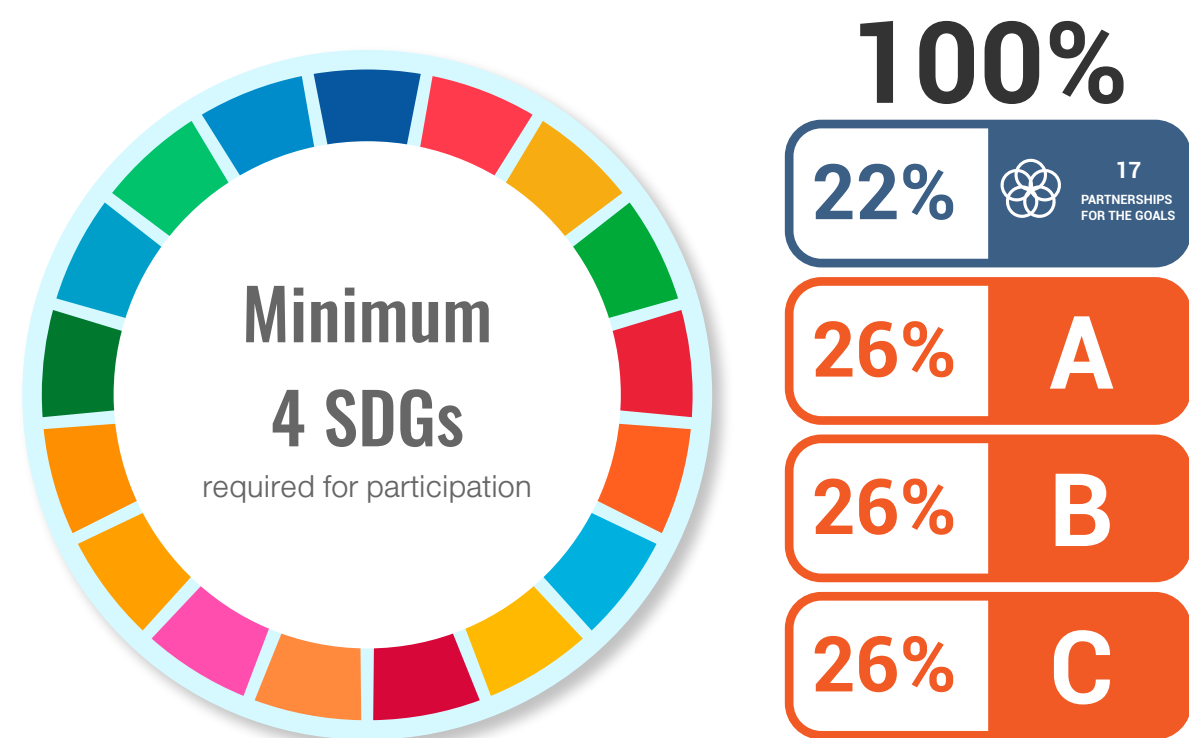


Methodology Section



Evidence is evaluated for relevance:
 1 point specific
 0.5 point general
 0 point not relevant

To participate in the overall ranking, universities must submit data to at least 4 SDGs, one of which must be SDG 17 – Partnership for the Goals. This means that different universities are scored based on a different set of SDGs, depending on their focus. If a university doesn't meet the requirement to be part of the overall ranking, they will still be assessed in the SDGs they submit data for. The overall score is scored by the SDG 17 (with a weight of up to 22% of the total score) and the three highest scores from other SDGs they report on (each worth up to 26% of the total score)

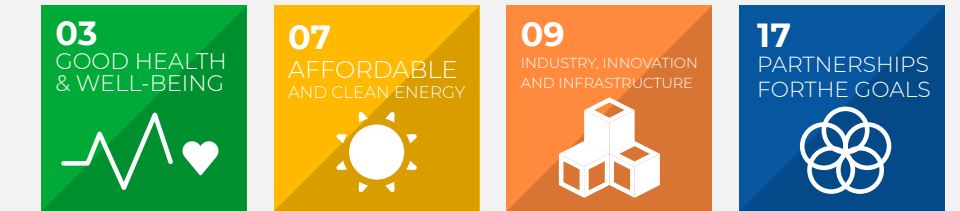

THE Impact Rankings 2023 (17 SDGs)



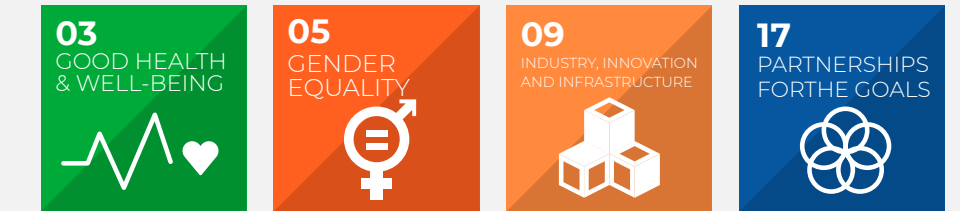

Changes from the 2023 Ranking

SDG	Change	Type of change
Overall score	A university's total score in a given year is calculated by combining its score in SDG 17 with its top three scores out of the remaining SDGs. The score for the overall ranking is an average of the last two year's total scores.	Changed Calculation
12.3	Guidance: Waste recycled In our context this refers to the university's implementation of waste diversion services to collect and recycle items such as paper, glass, organics, construction material, appliances and electronics. <i>This could also include waste that is "recycled" into energy.</i>	Added guidance
12.3	Guidance: Incineration Incineration is not counted as recycling and should not be included in "waste sent to landfill" <i>If the waste is incinerated to convert it into energy, you could include this in wasted recycled.</i>	Added guidance
17.1.2	Partnership for the goals: publications The number of publications look at the scale of research output from a university around research relating to SDGs 1 to 16. It is not scaled by the size of the institution – rather it looks at the overall impact.	Clarification
