Bachelor's Degree Program

Full-time Lecturers	Part-time Lecturers
<p>(1) Lecturer, assistant professor, associate professor, professor of the institution that offers the program</p> <p>(2) Have responsibility according to the mission of higher education and perform full-time duty.</p> <p>(3) Full-time lecturers accepted after 7 October 2015 must obtain the English proficiency test score according to the criteria specified by the Commission on Higher Education.</p>	<p>(1) Lecturer who is not full-time.</p>

Full-time Lecturers of the Program

Qualifications

1. Full-time Lecturer

2. Hold master's degree / assistant professor rank in the same or related field of study of the program

For Practical/Professional Program

>> Qualifications as required by professional standards (if any)

>> For program in cooperation with non-educational organization, staff from such organization who holds bachelor's degree program and has 6-year of working experience can be full-time lecturer of the program

3. Have academic product that is not part of graduation

4. At least 1 academic product has been publicized according to the criteria on academic appointment in the past 5 years

5. One can be full-time lecturer of the program for more than 1 program at the same time but all programs must be in the same or related field of study in which he/she graduates.

Same or related field of study of the program => as specified by TQF or ISCED

Responsible Lecturers of the Program

Qualifications

1. Same qualifications as full-time lecturers of the program.

2. Number of responsible lecturers of the program: 5

If providing concentration, the program must have 3 responsible lecturers per concentration.

For Practical / Professional Program

>> 2 out of 5 must have practical experience

>> For program in cooperation with non-educational organization, staff from such organization can be responsible lecturers of the program for no more than 2 persons.

>> For program that provides concentration, 1 out of 5 must have practical experience.

3. One cannot be responsible lecturer of the program for more than 1 program at the same time.

Except for the interdisciplinary or multidisciplinary program, only 2 can be responsible lecturers of the program for more than 1 program at the same time.

Practical experience = Work with company and possess evidence proving that his/her performance benefits to the company or have academic product on technology development or creative product on science and technology that is industry-related and has already been publicized.

Course Lecturer

Qualifications

1. Full-time or part-time lecturer

2. Hold master's degree / assistant professor rank in the same or related field of study of the course

>> Full-time lecturer who holds bachelor's degree and starts teaching before 7 October 2015 can continue teaching.

>> Part-time lecturer must hold at least bachelor's degree and have at least 6 years of working experience relating to the course. *The number of teaching hours must not exceed 50% of the course* and full-time lecturer must be responsible of such course.

3. Qualifications as required by professional standards (if any)

Note: CHE may announce to change that part-time lecturer can teach more than 50% of the course.
