

- 5. A graphing or scientific calculator (for Math Exam)













- 1. BRING their Thai citizenship I.D. card or passport (international applicants) to the examination venue as proof of identity.
- 2. Applicants must **PRESENT** their printed exam tickets at the Check-In area on the day of the exam.
- 3. Wear their school/university uniform for both the written and interview examinations (Jeans, T-shirts, sandals, or shoes with no straps are not allowed).
- 4. Be on time (Test takers who arrive at the examination room more than 15 minutes late will NOT be allowed to sit for the examinations).
- 5. **TURN OFF** their alarm function and mobile phone completely when entering the examination room. (Anyone whose mobile phone makes any sound will be asked to leave the room and will automatically fail the exam).
- 6. Test takers are allowed to bring only their ID card, pencils, pens, eraser, and liquid paper to their seats. PENCIL CASES ARE **NOT ALLOWED** AT THE SEATS.
- 7. Calculators allowed during math exam include most graphing calculators, all scientific calculators and all four-function calculators.
- 8. Test takers are **NOT** allowed to go to the toilet during the examination.
- 9. Anyone caught cheating on any examination will automatically fail every subjects.
