Note

Applicants must:

1. **BRING** their Thai citizenship I.D. card or passport (international applicants) to the examination venue as proof of identity.
2. Wear their school/university uniform for both the written and interview examinations (Jeans, T-shirt, sandals or shoes with no strap are **not allowed**).
3. Be on time (Applicants who arrive to the examination room more than 15 minutes late will **NOT** be allowed to sit for the examinations).
4. **TURN OFF** their mobile phone completely before entering the examination room. (Anyone whose mobile phone makes any sound will be asked to leave the room and will automatically fail the exam).
5. Applicants are allowed to bring only their ID card, pencils, pens, eraser and liquid paper to their seats. **PENCIL CASES ARE NOT ALLOWED AT THE SEATS.**
6. **Calculators** allowed during math exam include most graphing calculators, all scientific calculators and all four-function calculators.
7. Applicants are **NOT** allowed to go to the toilet during the examination.
8. Anyone caught cheating on any examination will automatically fail every subject.
