



**Announcement of Mahidol University International College
on No Gift Policy in Fiscal Year 2025**

Mahidol University has announced the No Gift Policy in Fiscal Year 2025 in accordance with the National Reform Plan on Preventing and Suppressing Corruption and Misconduct, specifically the implementation of the “No Gift Policy” as stated by the Office of Public Sector Anti-Corruption Commission (PACC).

In this regard, to ensure the effective implementation of the Announcement of Mahidol University on No Gift Policy in Fiscal Year 2025, Mahidol University International College, hereby, sets the policy as follows:

Clause 1 Mahidol University International College declares itself as “a unit that all of the College’s staff shall not accept gifts and favors of any kind before, while, or after performing their duties” to prevent any kind of corruption and misconduct.

Clause 2 Mahidol University International College has set a No Gift Policy/Guideline for staff as follows:

2.1 Mahidol University International College staff shall not accept gifts, favors, or any other benefits in the course of performing their duties;

2.2 Mahidol University International College staff shall not give gifts, favors, or any other benefits to external visitors;

2.3 Mahidol University International College staff shall not accept or give gifts, favors, or any other benefits to outsider persons, organizations, agencies, juristic persons that have been, are, or may become partners or contractors engaged with Mahidol University International College in procurement or contract activities.

Clause 3 Receiving or giving in accordance with customs, traditions, culture, or manners that are commonly performed should be considered as appropriate but must not have a price or value exceeding 3,000 Baht and be cautious of underestimating the value.

Clause 4 Instead of giving gifts, Mahidol University International College staff can instead give greeting cards, greeting books, condolences cards, or social media messages to express congratulations, best wishes, welcoming, or condolences on a variety of occasions.

/Clause 5...

Clause 5 All executives, chiefs, and heads of units shall emphasize and communicate the policy and practices guideline in this announcement to all personnel, ensuring strict compliance.

This announcement shall be effective today onwards.
