### **OVERVIEW:**

With an emphasis on global citizenship, the Intercultural Studies and Languages(ICIC) program fosters cultural appreciation, critical thinking skills, ethical leadership, and creative problem solving. This major brings together diverse aspects of a humanities/liberal arts education.

A broad range of methods, perspectives, and challenges are explored in the areas of language, culture, and thought.

All students in the ICIC major are required to take a set of common core courses designed to introduce them to key concepts and practices in the field of Intercultural Studies and then choose one of following concentrations:

FOREIGN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE; LITERARY AND CULTURAL STUDIES; ETHICS, PHILOSOPHY, AND ECONOMICS



#### **CONCENTRATIONS:**

FOREIGN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE (FLC) — A CITIZEN OF A GLOBAL COMMUNITY The Foreign Language and Culture Concentration promotes multilingualism, interactivity, and crosscultural skills. Students will not only develop communicative skills in their chosen foreign languages but also acquire knowledge about multiple cultures, ideas, and interpersonal soft skills. The FLC students will study one modern language to an intermediate Level (French B1, German B1, Spanish B1, Chinese Level 4, Japanese B1 or N3) while learning a second foreign language at a basic level.

# **LITERARY AND CULTURAL STUDIES (LCS)** — A **CRITICAL OBSERVER** The Literary and Cultural Studies Concentration investigates the cultural complexity of modern societies through stories and histories.

The LCS students will develop invaluable skills in writing and expression,



as well as new ways of understanding socio-historical contexts and making sense of the world, preparing them to think originally and innovate across diverse environments.

## ETHICS, PHILOSOPHY, AND ECONOMICS (EPE) — AN INDEPENDENT THINKER

Moving beyond traditional academic boundaries, this interdisciplinary concentration focuses on the intersection of ethics, philosophy, and economics, analyzing concepts such as values, virtues, and economic action. With social, technological and scientific trends transforming individuals and organizations, students will be equipped with information, methods, and tools to face a world where ideas and practices continue to evolve and cross pollinate in order to become future mediators, leaders, and decision makers.
