FOR MAHIDOL UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

Macquarie University recognises Mahidol University International College's (MUIC) Medical Pathway program (MPP) and Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Biological Sciences as suitable preparation in both content and structure for entry to Macquarie University's Doctor of Medicine (MD). These programs will be recognised for entry purposes subject to applicants meeting all other entry requirements via the normal competitive process.

This recognition is based on entry requirements and course content for these programs as represented by Mahidol University to Macquarie University.

- The MPP is a 2-year (6 trimester) accelerated non-award course
- The BSc major in Biological Science is a 4-year bachelor degree
