Announcement on Teaching and Learning for the Remaining Trimester 2/2020-21

Referring to the announcement of Mahidol University on the extension of the closure on Mahidol University Salaya campus dated 2nd January 2021, Mahidol University International College would like to make the following announcements applicable from 15 February 2021:

1. **All teaching and learning activities resume back on campus.** Lecturers are required to offer simultaneous online session to accommodate students who are unable to attend on-campus classes. The Office of Student Affairs will issue an excuse letter for these students under the following conditions: (a) under quarantine; (b) living in 'red' zoned areas and not allowed to travel; (c) parents not giving permission to attend in-person classes. Students requiring an excuse letter can make a request by filling out the form via the link <https://bit.ly/360wfrB>.
2. All lab and studio classes and activities resume on-campus.
3. One-day field trip is allowed.
4. Student internships can be: (a) work from home internships; (b) onsite internships but will require parents to sign the consent form provided by their respective divisions.
5. **All course assessments will remain online until the end of the Trimester 2/2020-21.**

This announcement is in effect until further notice subjected to Mahidol University's policy.
