



Announcement of Mahidol University International College
on Measures and Procedures in the Epidemic Situation of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)
B.E.2564 (A.D. 2021)

Measures and Procedures in the Epidemic Situation of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) are to be related with Announcement of Mahidol University on Opening of Mahidol University in all areas and Procedures in the Epidemic Situation of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) announced on 31 January B.E. 2564.

By the virtue of clause 14 of the Regulations of Mahidol University on the Administration of International College, College of Management and College of Music B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010) and the Amendment Version, Mahidol University International College has stipulated this announcement detailed as follows.

Clause 1 MUIC faculty, staff and students must maintain strict safety.

Clause 2 General safety practices for MUIC faculty, staff and students are as follows:

2.1 General safety practice for everyone

- a. Wear masks at all times except during drinking and eating (Masks must have a well-fitting nose-bridge).
- b. Keep social distance of at least one arm length (~1 meter).
- c. Wash your hands with soap and water or alcohol gel frequently.
- d. Put both a facemask and a face shield on a staff/student who is suspected to have COVID-19 and take them to a quarantine area. Staffs who are responsible to take them to the quarantine area must also be wearing a mask and face shield.
- e. Food and drinks must be consumed at the specific area in a canteen and outdoors. No food or drink in the library and co-working space.

/f. The maximum...

f. The maximum occupancy for all labs, classrooms, library and co-working space must be observed.

g. Steps to take before entering the building:

- i. Temperature scan.
- ii. Scan your ID or sign in (if you do not have an ID).
- iii. Wash your hands with alcohol gel.

2.2 General safety practice for MUIC faculty and staff

a. Wear masks at all time except during drinking and eating (Masks must have a well fitting nose-bridge).

b. Keep social distance of at least one arm length (~1 meter).

c. Wash your hands with soap and water or alcohol gel frequently.

d. Food and drinks must be consumed at the specific area in a canteen and outdoors.

e. Lecturers should be more flexible with the class time and allow students time to eat and drink.

f. Lecturers must wear a mask during lecture.

2.3 Other guidelines concerning student activities and behaviors

a. Prohibit heavy physical activities that might involve touching and yelling such as Thai boxing, dancing, cheering and singing. Clubs can send a special request with the proper COVID-19 safety measure and permission will be allowed on the case-by-case basis.

b. Smoking room maximum occupancy must be observed and e-cigarettes are banned.

c. Disciplinary measure will be taken for students who consistently violate the safety measure.

d. Students are encouraged to bring their own utensils, water, and pens.

2.4 Guidelines for lab

a. Instructors must wear both a mask and face shield at all time.

b. Students must wear a mask at all times. (Masks must have a well fitting nose-bridge).

Clause 3 Elevator usage

3.1 Must not exceed the maximum occupancy of the elevator.

3.2 You are encouraged to use stairs if the elevator is full.

3.3 Wear a mask in the elevator at all times.

3.4 Do not eat or drink in the elevator.

Clause 4 Foods and drinks

4.1 Wash your hands with soap and water or alcohol gel before and after food consumption.

4.2 Only consume food and drinks at the specific area in a canteen and outdoors.

4.3 Put your mask back on after you finish food/drink consumption.

Clause 5 Operating hours for buildings

5.1 Aditayathorn Building 06.00 – 18.00.

5.2 Old Building 06.00 –18.00 for the building, but the basement will be open until 20.00.

Clause 6 Anyone traveling to MUIC by public transportation should change their clothes and masks upon reaching campus before beginning work.

Clause 7 Disposable masks will be provided for maids and security guards.

This announcement shall be effective from now onwards.
