**Message from the Dean of Mahidol University International College Regarding
Tuition Fee Reduction (dated 18th April 2020)**

We understand that the current COVID-19 pandemic is challenging and difficult for our community. As a result, we have already discussed your concerns and proposed our solution regarding tuition and university fees to Mahidol University (MU). Subsequently, MU is taking our proposal into account and a policy/guideline regarding tuition reduction will be formulated for implementation by all the faculties within MU. Once this guideline is confirmed, MUIC will be able to initiate the process for tuition reduction for Term 3. However, since our term would have started by then, your tuition reduction will likely come in the form of a refund.

For students who need financial assistance during this difficult time, an initial set of scholarship funds will be made available at 10,000 baht per scholarship. Priority will be given to those who need to pay a leave of absence fee. The rest of the scholarships will be granted on a need-based basis. Scholarship applications will be accepted from April 28 to May 8. Please contact the Office of Students Affairs for more details.
