THE PROGRAMME

Progression to Master's degree at Liverpool John Moores University

This progression programme offers the opportunity for Mahidol University International College (MUIC) students to enrol at Liverpool John Moores University (LJMU), after completing their degree at MUIC. After completing the programme, students will receive a Bachelor's Degree from MUIC and a Master's Degree from LJMU.

Entry Requirements: Entry in September 2022

- A minimum overall average CGPA of 2.4 out of 4 in relevant Bachelor's degree programme at Mahidol University International College (MUIC).
- 6.0 Overall with 5.5 in each component
- Expected graduation date within July 2022

After completing the programme, you will receive a Bachelor's Degree from Mahidol University International College and a Master's Degree from Liverpool John Moores University.

Scholarships

Students who apply through this progression programme are eligible for a £3,500 Regional Scholarship. Scholarships awarded by LJMU come in the form of tuition fee discounts. These are applied to your overall, remaining fee after your first tuition fee instalment has been received.

In order to qualify for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a self-funded international student.
- Meet the conditions stated in your full-time Postgraduate Taught course offer letter.
- Not already be benefiting from an existing scholarship award of sponsorship.

This Country Scholarship is automatically awarded to eligible postgraduate students upon assessment of their initial application to this progression programme.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW WHEN BOOKING YOUR STUDENT ACCOMMODATION



CONTRACTS

Accommodation contracts are known as 'tenancy agreements' or 'tenancies' and are legally binding for the full period once signed. So unless there are exceptional grounds for the tenancy to be cancelled, you are liable for rent until the end of the contract or until a replacement is found.

Tenancies commence on Saturday, 17 September 2022 and finish 42 weeks later on Friday 7 July 2023. Induction week for new students starts on 19 September and teaching begins on Thursday 22 September 2022.

It is important to note that all tenancies cover the full academic year. If your course does not match the standard academic year – for example Nursing or Midwifery – you will be given a full calendar year tenancy as standard.

Don't forget that you don't have to move out over the Christmas and Easter breaks, the room is yours for the duration of your contract. You can also stay on after your first year in all cases.

MONEY MATTERS

Rent is paid in three equal instalments that coincide with your student funding payments if you are a UK student, who can provide a guarantor*, so it is important that you apply for your student funding as soon as possible – don't put this off!

It is a good idea to try and work out your budget at this stage and choose your accommodation according to what you can afford.

*Your guarantor will most likely be a parent or guardian, and they must agree to act in this capacity

MATURE STUDENTS

The majority of students entering accommodation come to university straight from school or college and are under 21. If you prefer a quieter study environment, rooms are reserved for older students at a number of our city centre locations.

If you do have any particular requests, such as living in a flat with older students, please indicate this on your accommodation request form. Every effort will be made to meet your needs but this cannot be guaranteed in all cases. If you would prefer to live in a private house or flat, contact Liverpool Student Homes (LSH) **liverpoolstudenthomes.org/accommodation.**

HEALTHCARE STUDENTS

Nursing, midwifery and paramedic students have different schedules due to placement work, often getting up when other students are going to bed! For this reason we strongly recommend healthcare students choose Atlantic Point, Glassworks, Marybone 1 or Marybone 3 and share their flat with students on similar courses.

Limited parking is available for Paramedic students at Atlantic Point.

Students requiring accommodation for courses commencing in January 2023 should check ljmu.ac.uk/ accommodation from January 2022 onwards to see what options are available.

DISABLED STUDENTS

Accommodation facilities for students with disabilities are constantly improving and LJMU is committed to ensure a high standard of living for all students, whatever your needs. If you require accommodation with particular adaptations it is important that you inform us as soon as possible so that the necessary arrangements can be made. BOOKING YOUR ACCOMMODATION

MAKE YOUR CHOICE

Read the information here and online **ljmu.ac.uk/accommodation** and decide where you would like to live.

SUBMIT YOUR REQUEST

Once LJMU is your Firm (first) choice, you can submit your accommodation request via the applicant area of our website from 1 February 2022. Bedrooms are allocated on a first come, first served basis and you can submit your request regardless of whether you hold a conditional or unconditional offer.

FINALISE YOUR BOOKING

Within 10 days of submitting your request you will be contacted by your chosen accommodation provider by email. You must follow their instructions and make the initial payment requested in order to finalise the booking of your room.

If you hold a conditional offer from LJMU and are unsuccessful, any payment made fo accommodation will be refunded and your tenancy agreement cancelled.

You can contact our Accommodation Office at any time for advice and guidance.

Don't forget, booking your room via the LJMU Accommodation Office is the only way to be sure of living with other new LJMU students.
