

## **Partnership Programme**

**4+1:** Open to students following one of the participating MUIC Bachelor programmes:

BBA Business Economics - BBA Finance - BBA International Business - BBA Marketing - BA International Relations and Global Affairs (see full details on the dedicated Queen Mary page of MUIC's website!)

On successful completion of the MUIC Bachelor, you will join Queen Mary to complete your Postgraduate programme in the School of Business and Management (SBM) or School of Politics and International Relations (SPIR).

#### Entry requirements:

Applicants should:

- Obtain a minimum of 3.0 out of 4.0 GPA from MUIC's Bachelor degree
- Meet the English language requirements
- Meet any other specific entry requirements of the programme they are applying for (see the Queen Mary website)

# **English Language Requirements**

- Applicants must meet the English language components for the programme applied
- School of Business and Management: IELTS: 7.0 overall (min.6.0 in all sub-tests)
- School of Politics and International Relations: IELTS 7.0 overall (min.6.5 W, 5.5 S, L, R)

# Postgraduate programme structure

Late September – mid-December Semester 1 4-5 modules (varies per programme) Mid-January – end March Semester 2 4-5 modules (varies per programme) April – mid-June Semester 3 Examination period Mid-June to September Dissertation Write your dissertation September: Assessment of Dissertation Submit your dissertation

### Fees and costs

- Tuition fee cost varies depending on the programme
- SBM:

**January 2024:** £28,950

**September 2024** £24,000 - £31,850

SPIR:

**September 2024** £24,000

- MUIC students receive a 10% scholarship on tuition fees
- Cost of living is ~£1,334 per month.
- Housing on campus ranges from £181-£320 per week

- Meal plan options also available


# **Apply for a CAS**

- You need a CAS to apply for your visa
- You can apply for a CAS once you have received an unconditional offer from Queen Mary from 6 months before the start date of your course

# Working in the UK

 During your studies, you are permitted to work for a maximum of 20 hours per week.

 Students are able to work for a period of 2 years after they have completed their studies with a Graduate Visa.



# **Key facts**

- Two sessions (3 weeks):
  - 30 June-21 July and 21 July-11 Aug
- Study one module per session
  - wide range of courses
  - 15 Queen Mary credits (4 US credits or 7.5 ECTS)
- Receive a transcript
  - assessed by written assignment and presentation
- Choose any module no pre-requisites
  - Make sure your university will accept the credit
- Application deadline 24 May 2024
