This programme is aimed at students from non-European universities who wish to spend a semester or two at an Austrian University of Applied Sciences ('Fachhochschule').

AWARDS

The monthly grant rate is <u>EUR 1,050</u> (depending on the study duration)

WHO CAN APPLY - students with the following qualifications

- Have completed at least three trimesters of study at MUIC
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Achieve a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.85 at the time of application (students who have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.70 will be considered on a case-by-case basis)
- Provide a TOEFL IBT score of at least 69 or Academic IELTS Overall score of at least 6.0
- Participate in the Buddy Program with the Student Exchange Office for at least 1 trimester or participate in Special Projects with Project Development Unit for at least 14 days
- Apply to be an exchange student at the following universities
 - o Management Center Innsbruck
 - o Salzburg University of Applied Sciences
 - o University of Applied Science, Krems

1. submit Student Exchange Application along with your essay about "What would you gain from studying in Austria in relation to your selected field of study?"

2. work with student exchange office to submit relevant documents to partner universities
