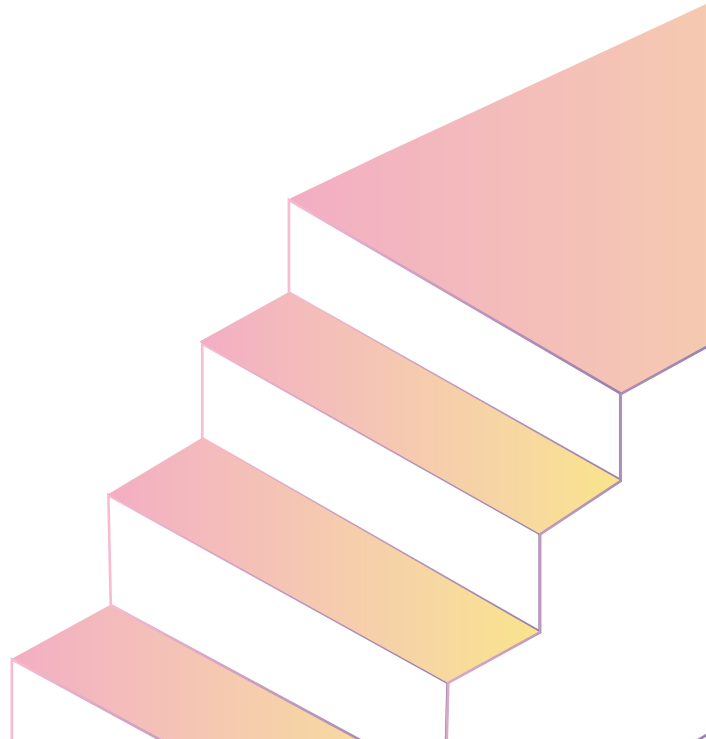

Two Former MUIC Deans Receive Prestigious MU Venerable Person Award

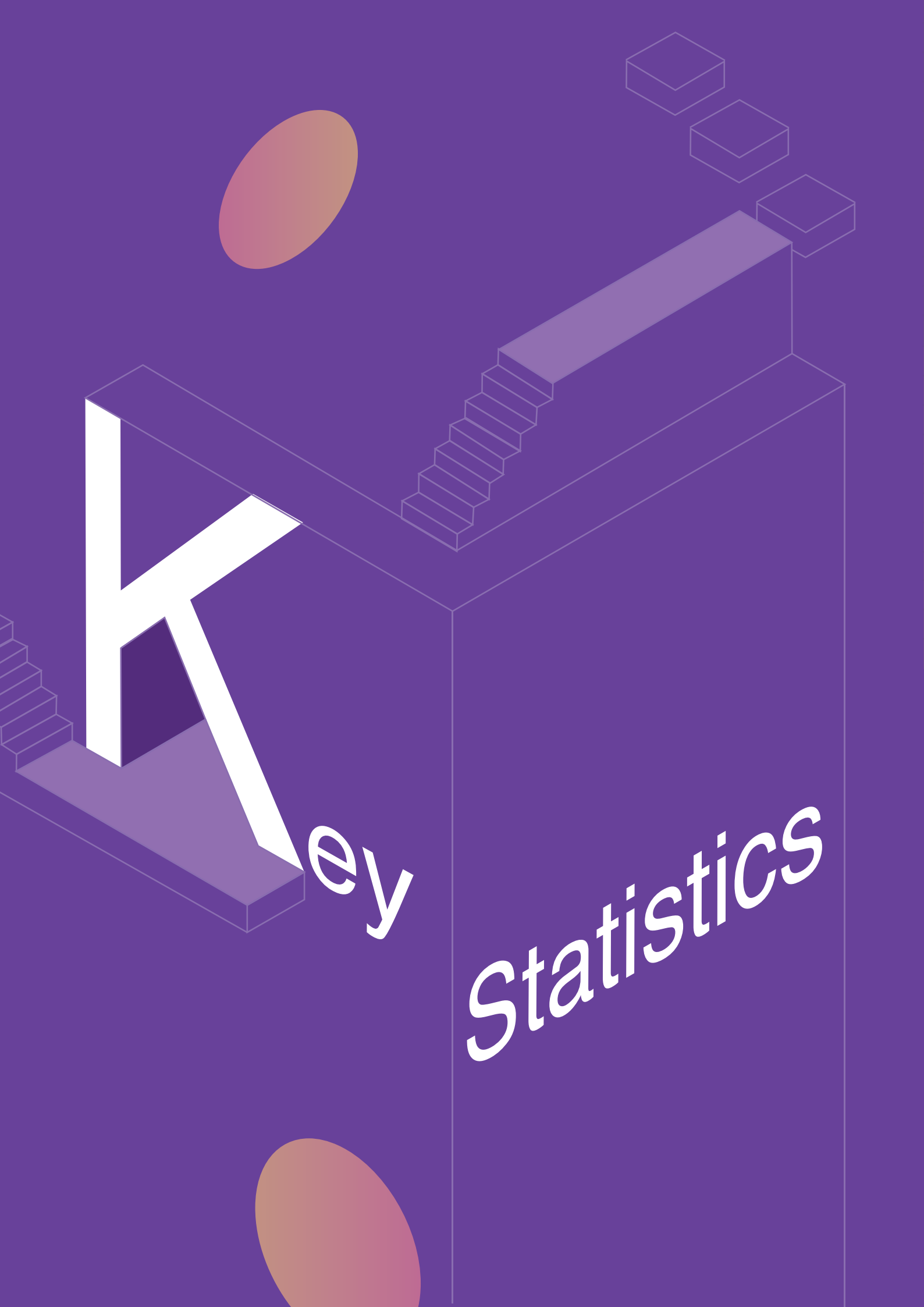
Mahidol University International College (MUIC) honored two of its former deans who recently received a prestigious award from Mahidol University.

It is awarded to persons who best represent Mahidol University's mission of being good role models who bring honor to the university.

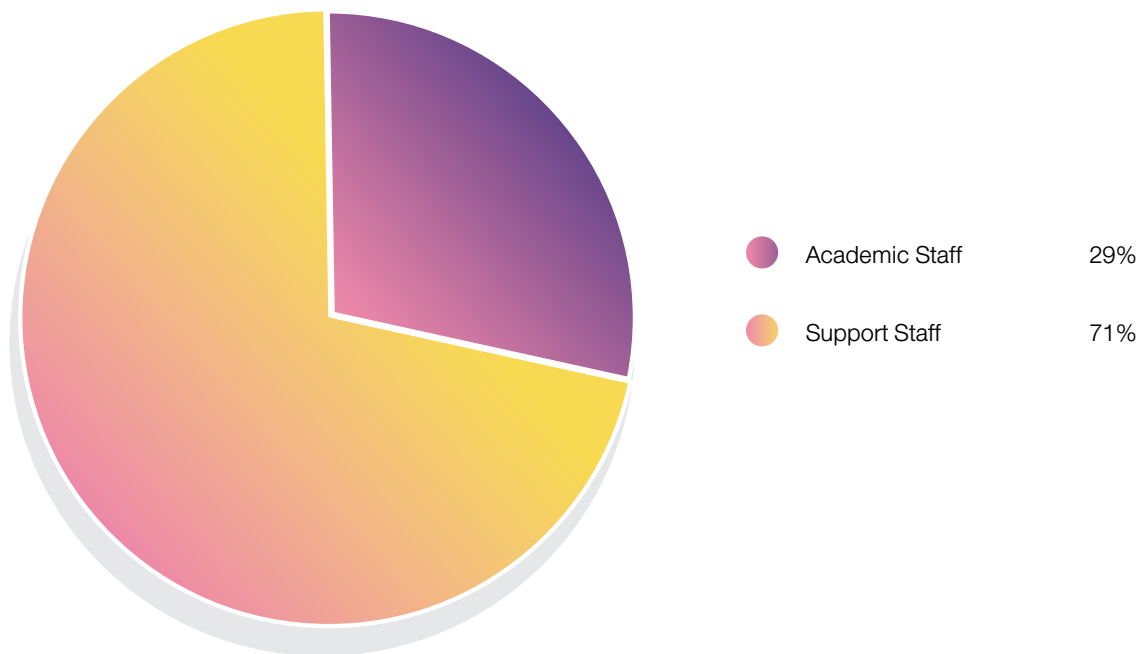
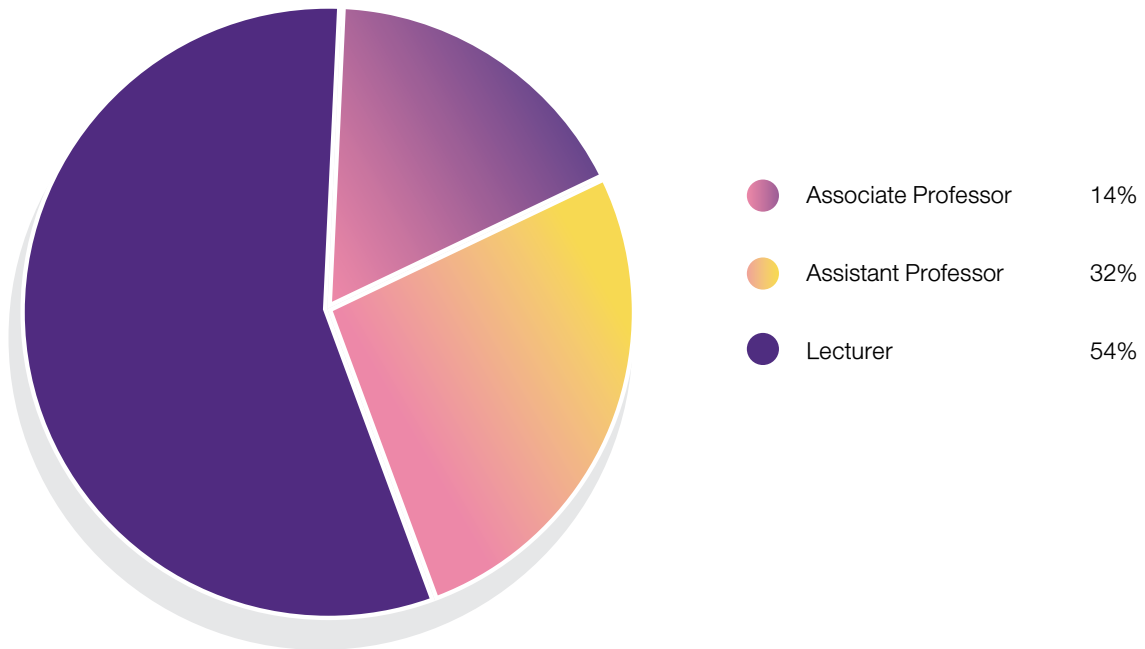

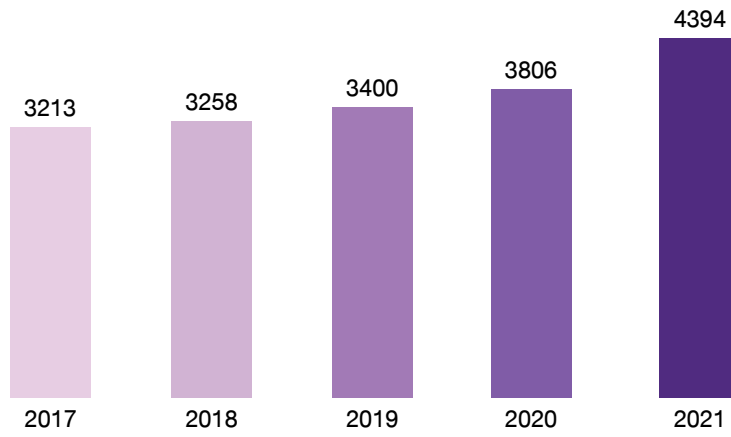

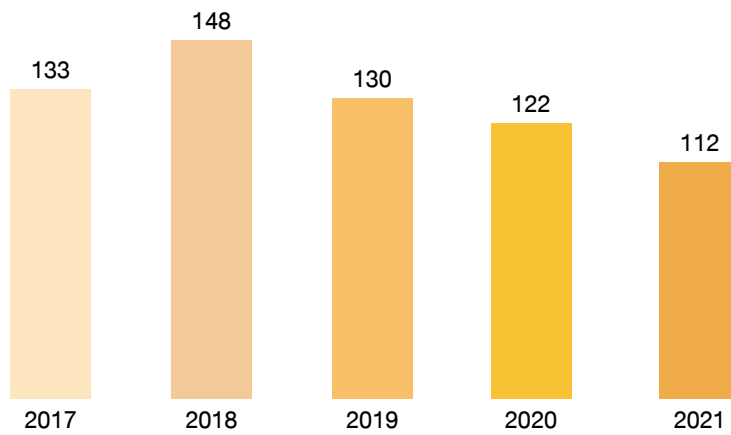


Number of Full-time Students

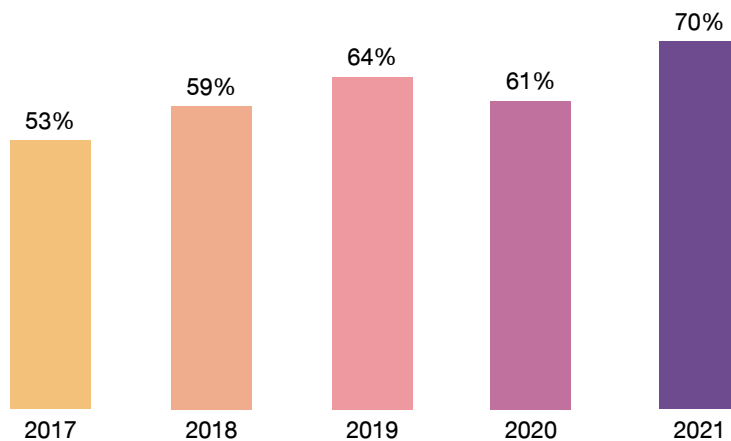

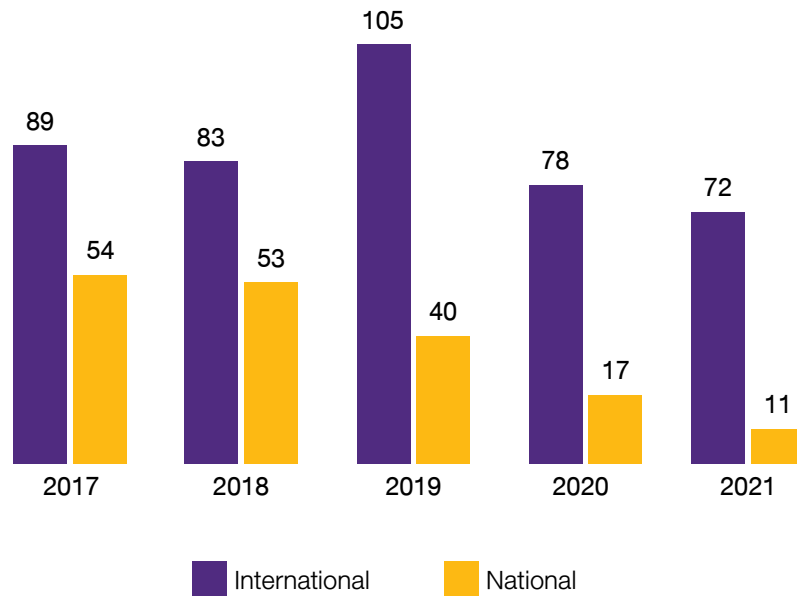
Publications per Division (2017-2021)

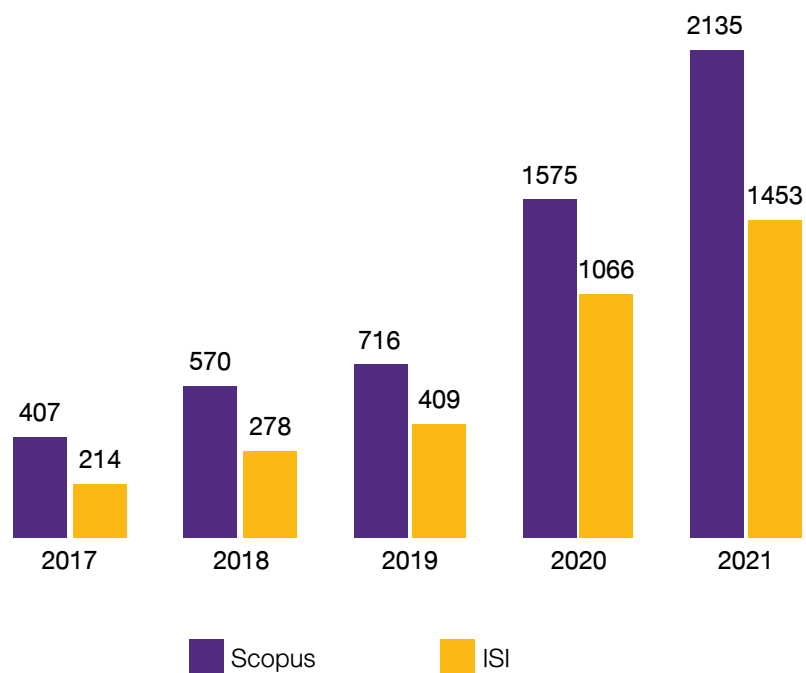

Visualizing Stravinsky

“Visualizing Stravinsky” motion graphic for live philharmonic orchestra performance project created and art directed by Communication Design Program faculty; Asst.Prof.Dale Konstanz and Dr.Dynaya Bhutipunthu, is a project involving an original motion graphic projection created to accompany live philharmonic orchestra performances of Igor Stravinsky’s ‘The Rite of Spring’. The final multimedia piece was launched in January 2020 during two Stravinsky concerts by the Thailand Philharmonic Orchestra. It was well-attended by patrons of the arts and members of the community, including those associated with Mahidol University where the venue, Prince Mahidol Hall, is located. The goal in developing the work was to create visuals that harmonize with the music, yet are impactful and add aesthetic value to the orchestra’s performances. Although ‘The Rite of Spring’ was originally composed for ballet, the motion graphics were a substitute for dancers with a set on a stage, thereby creating a more contemporary environment for the music. Beasts and Children



FAA lecturer, Bryan Ott wins the GRAND PRIZE at the Rhode Island International Film Festival Screenplay Competition 2019 [for the second time] with his latest feature screenplay entitled They Sound Human. Selected from 550 script entries, Bryan Ott's award winning script is the narrative sequel to his 2017 grand prize entry Beasts and Children. They Sound Human, a horror western told from the point of view of a female Irish-immigrant in 1865, explores the journey of a single mother set out in search of her missing daughter whom she fears has been abducted by local orphan traders. To make matters worse, demonic beasts roam the woods intent on luring abandoned children to their doom.

As a means to further explore my PhD dissertation, completed at Deakin University in Melbourne 2021, this graphic novel is the means to test and explore the process of writing a post-feminist narrative as a male screenwriter influenced by Hollywood practice and screenwriting craft history.

A Systematic Review

A systematic review of cognitive biases in tourist decisions.

This study examines articles related to tourist decision making, especially with respect to cognitive biases, published in the Journal of Travel Research, Annals of Tourism Research, and Tourism Management over the past 10 years (from January 2008 to September 2018). Tourists do not always make rational choices due to the influence of behavioral factors, such as dispositions and emotions. According to the study of judgment and decision making, cognitive biases are the main underlying causes of suboptimal decisions. Through a systematic analysis, this study reveals the prevalence and influence of common biases at different stages of travel, such as pre-trip, on-site, and post-trip. This study also summarizes implications for tourism management and proposes areas of potential research contributions. <https://www.sciencedirect.com/science/article/pii/S0261517719301219>

Students Compete in Video Contest on Dangers of E-cigarette

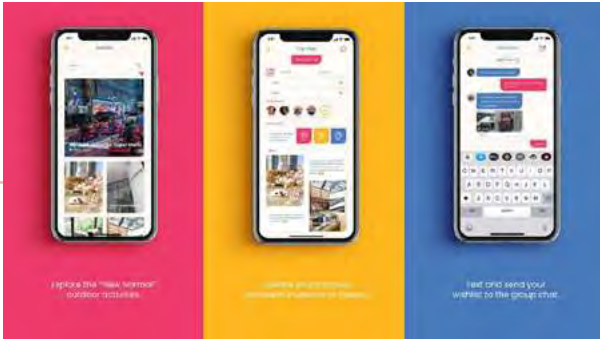

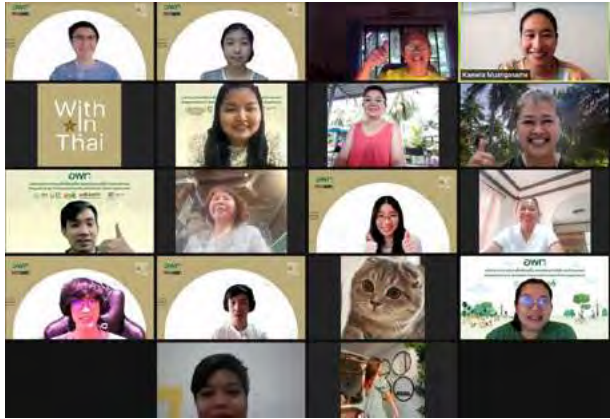
Pai-ja

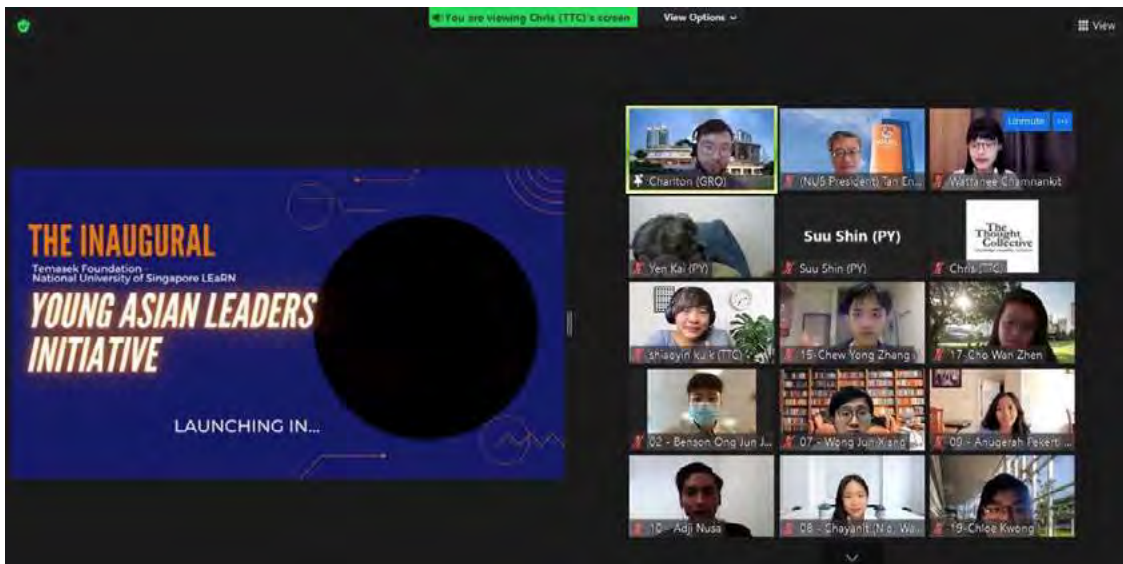
THM Masters Student Finalist in Tourism Contest in Switzerland

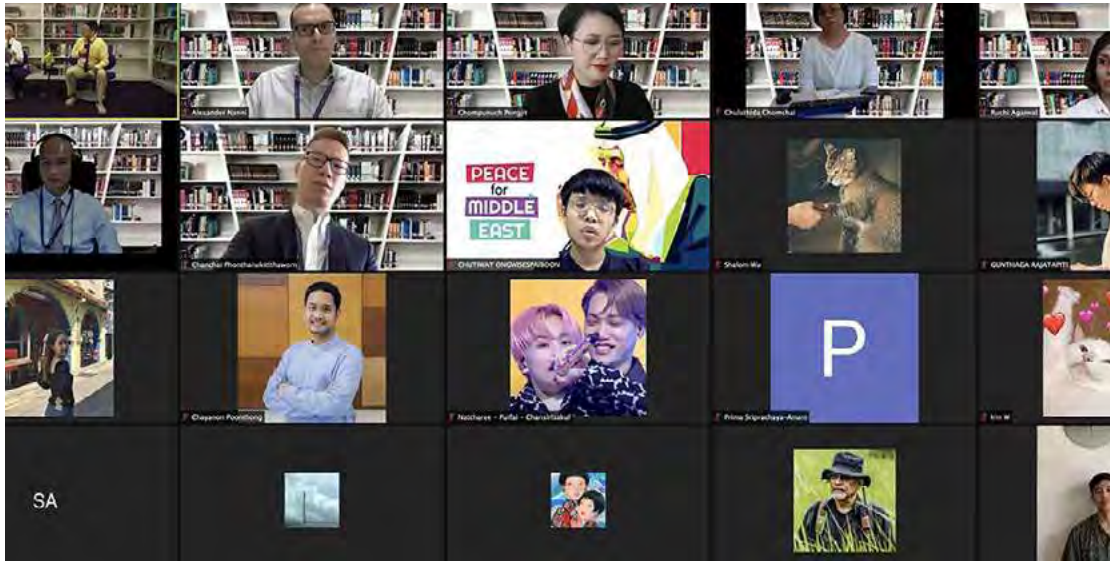
MUIC Stages Virtual Open Days 2021

Trick or Treat at MUIC

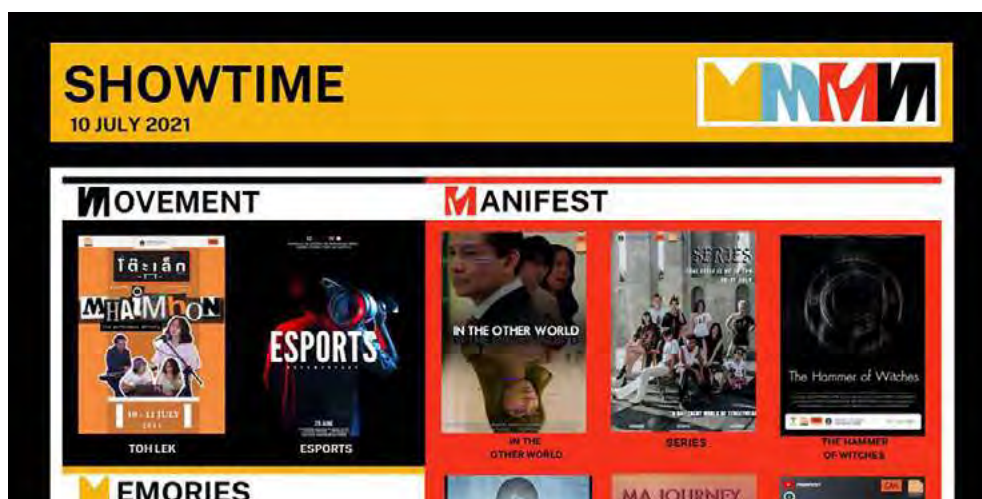

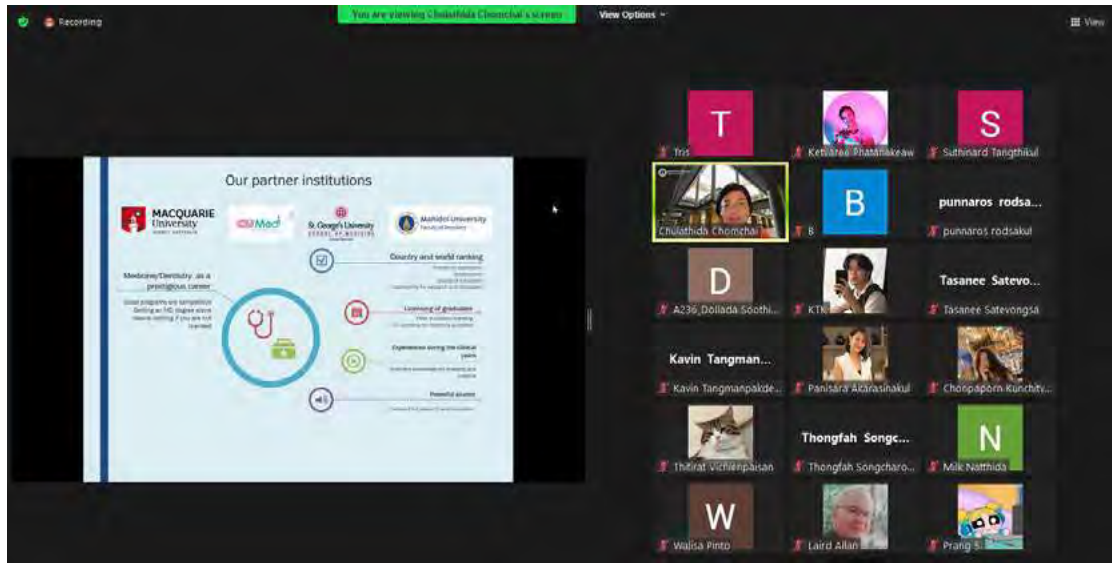
MUIC Holds Online Study Tour 2021 Program for Marquette University

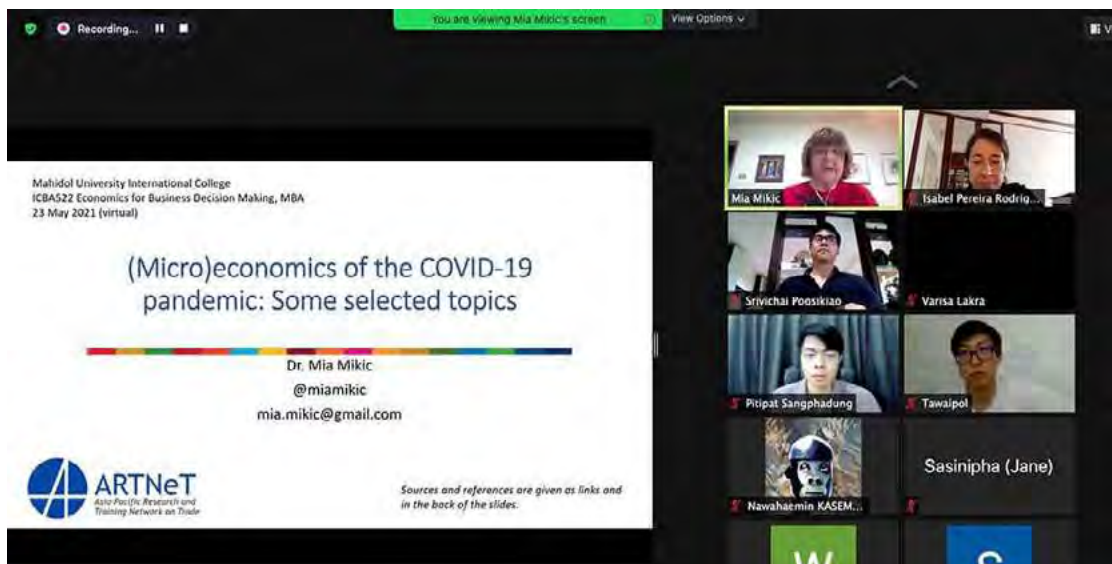
THM Co-hosts Glocal Webinar on Women in Tourism Industry

MUIC Holds Online Talk on Opportunities in Medical and Dental Schools

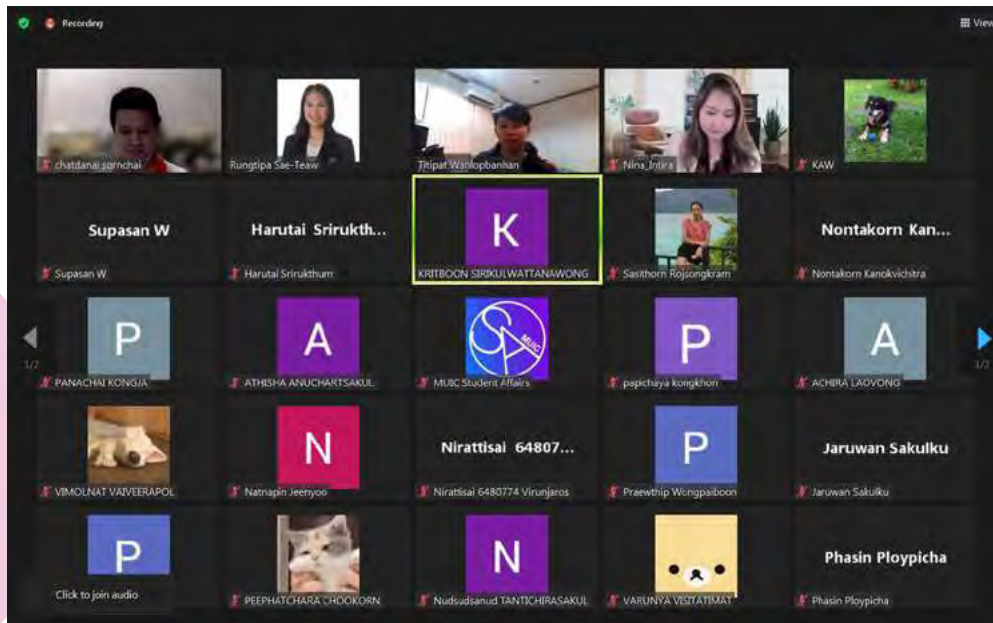

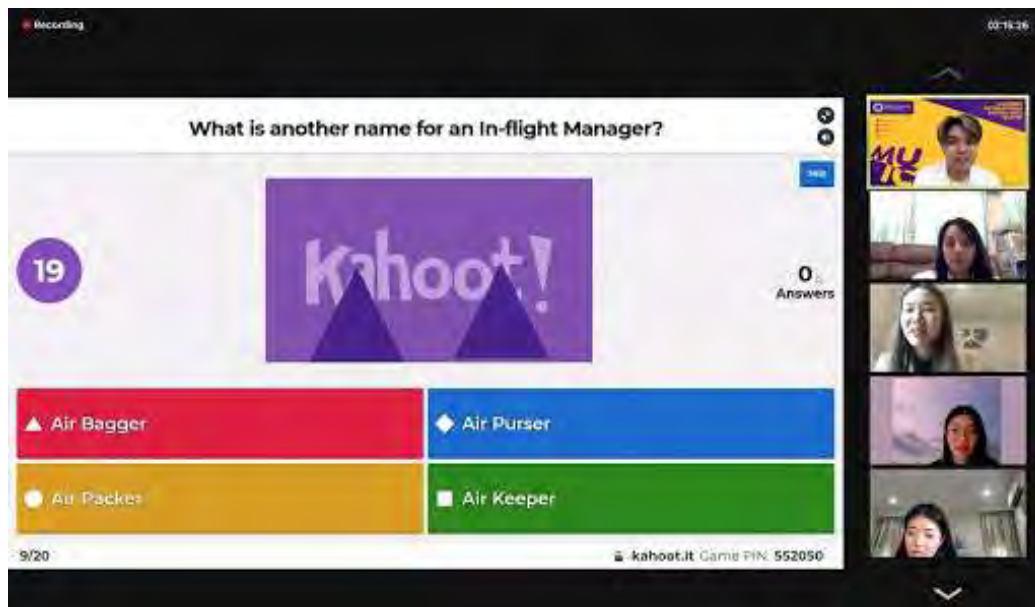
Online Classroom Survival Kit for MUIC Students

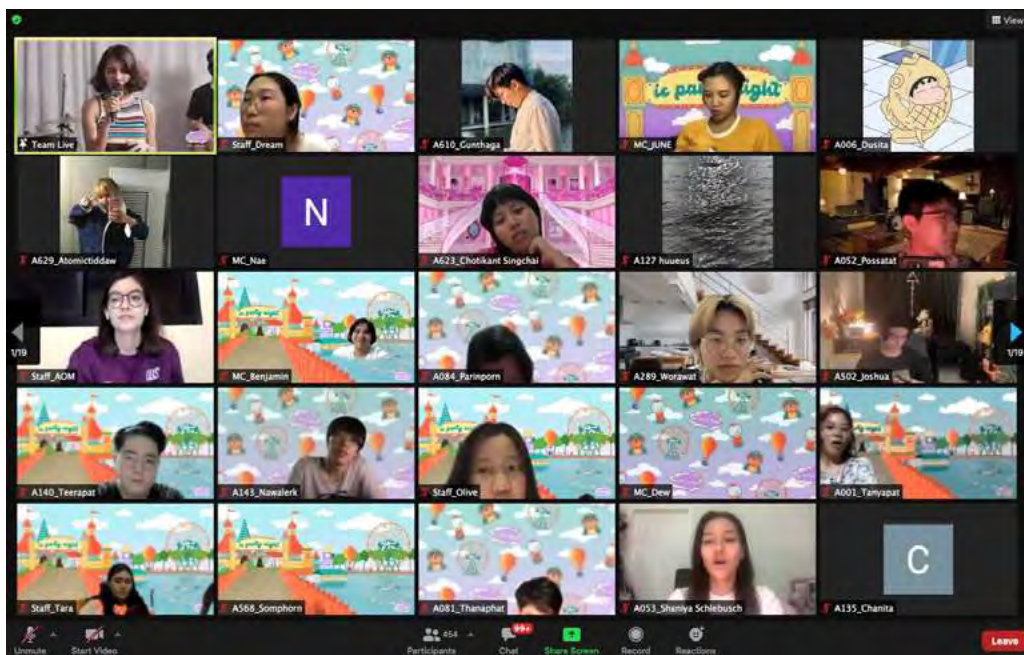
Airline Pilot and In-flight Manager in Career Talk

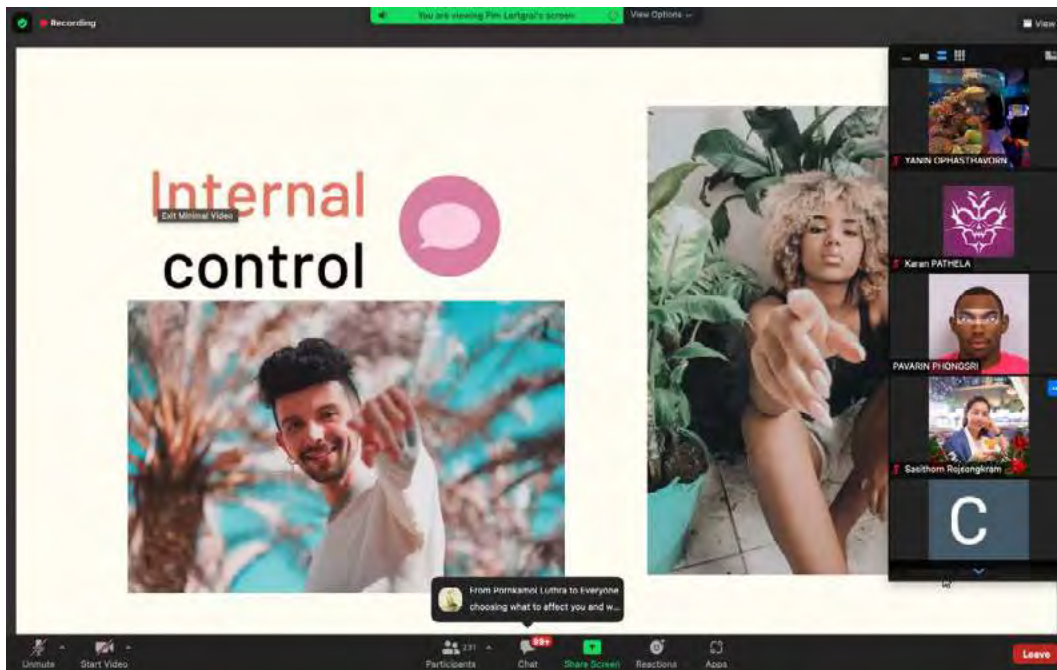
IC Party Night

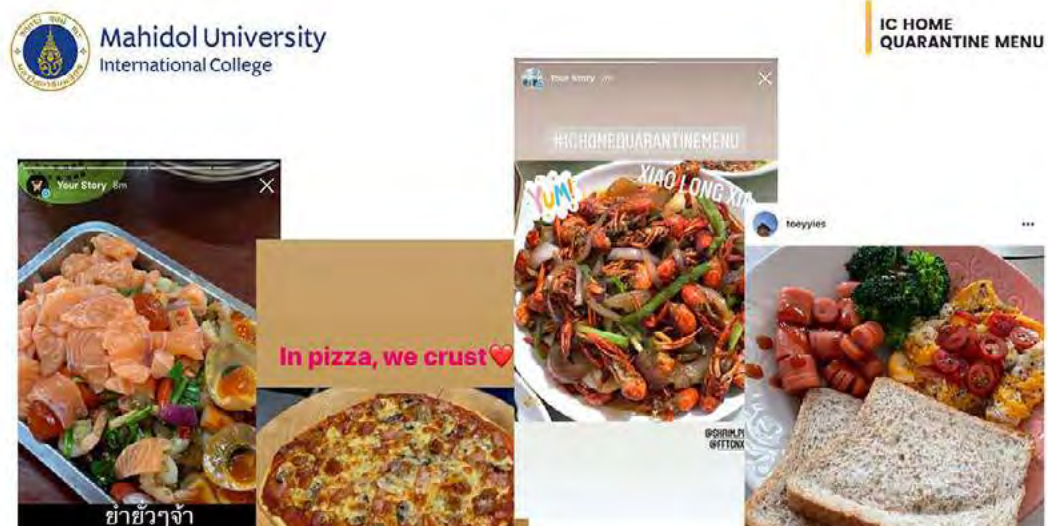
Online Rubnong "NETFLIX"

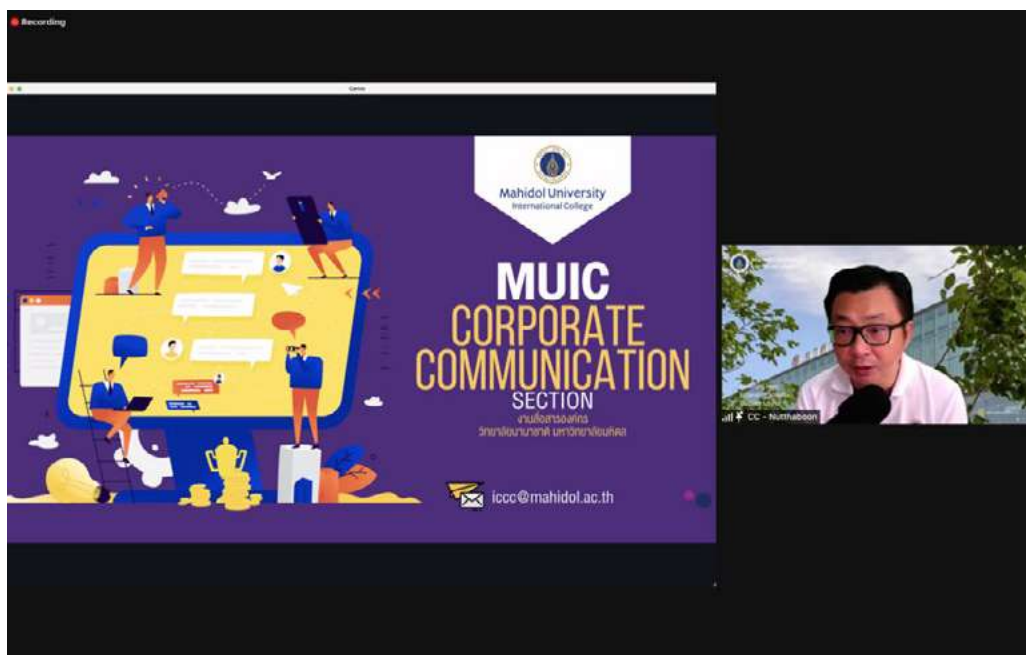
Upperclassmen Meet Their Juniors in “Major-Ma-Jer”

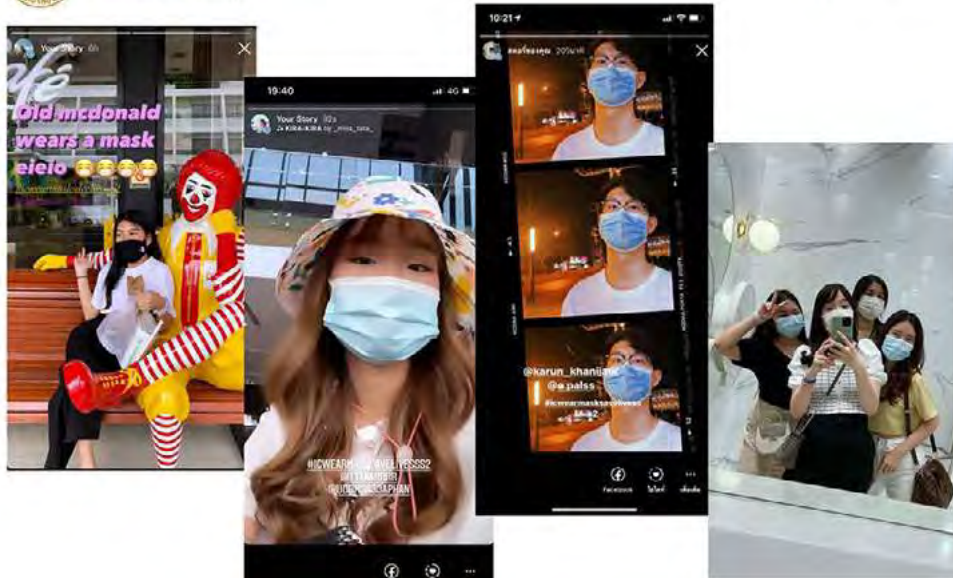

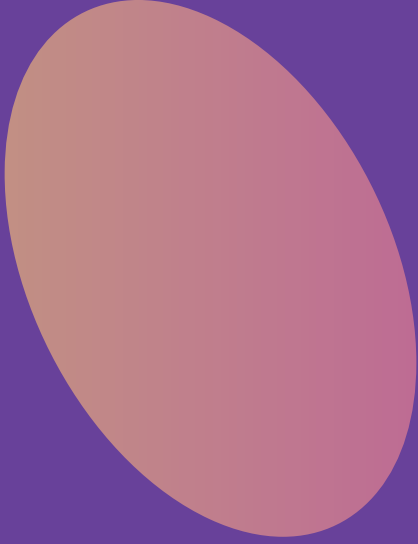

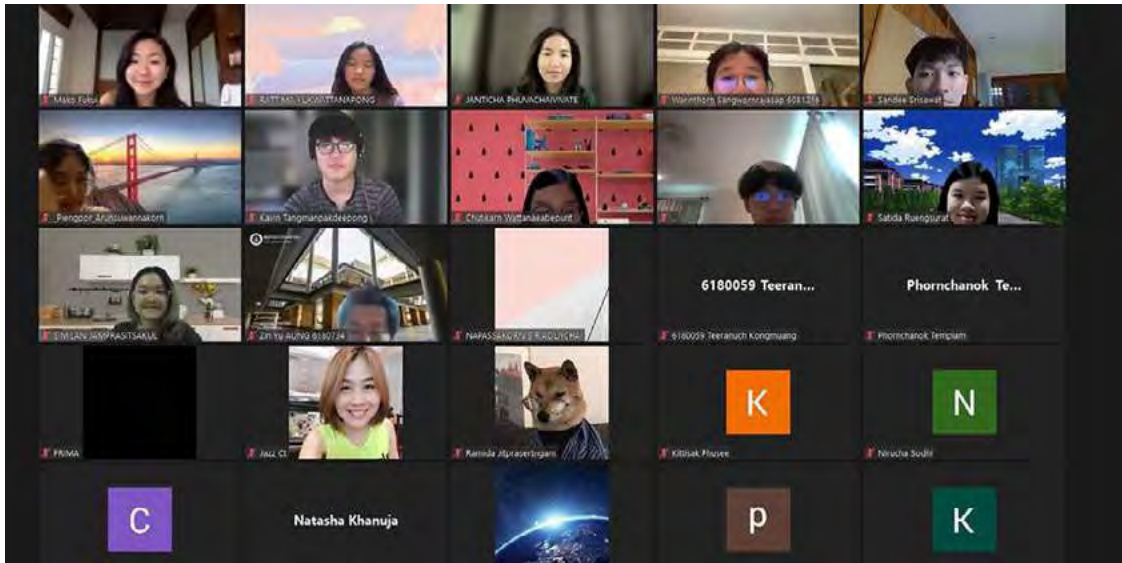
2D Dystopian Character Design Contest

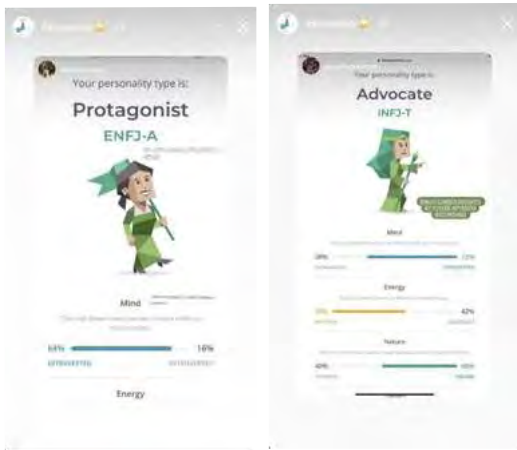

MUN Crossword Competition

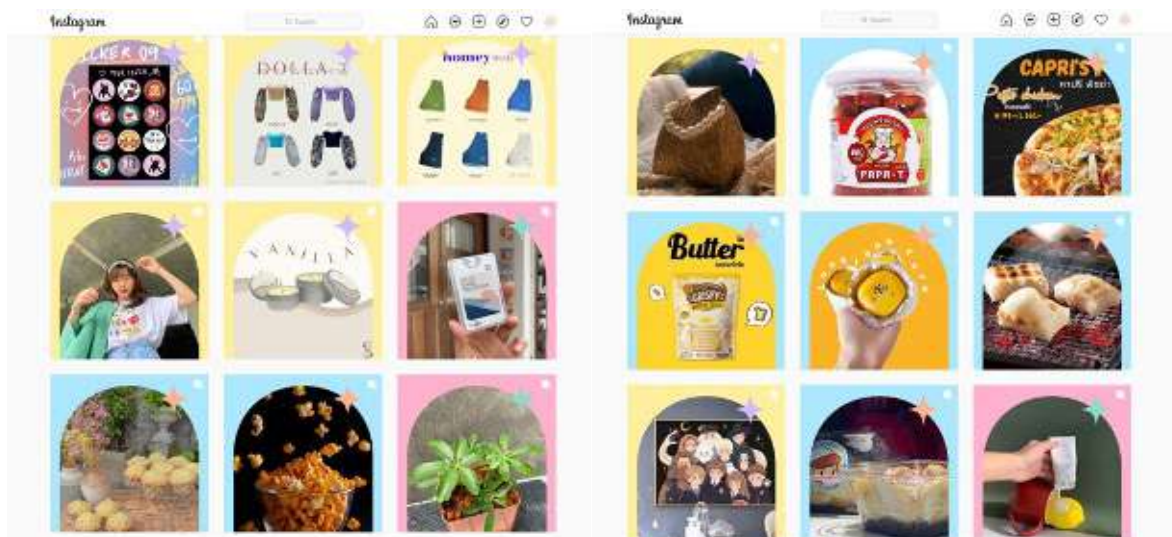

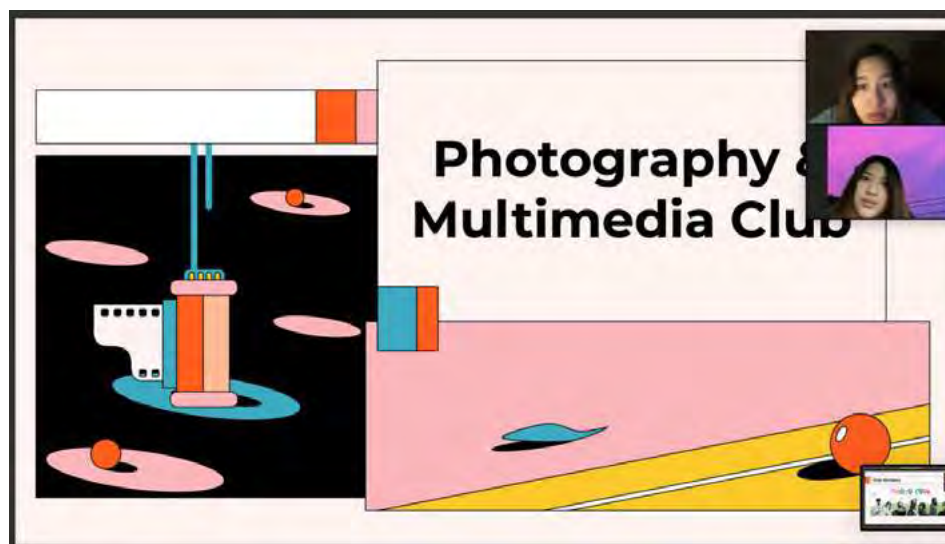
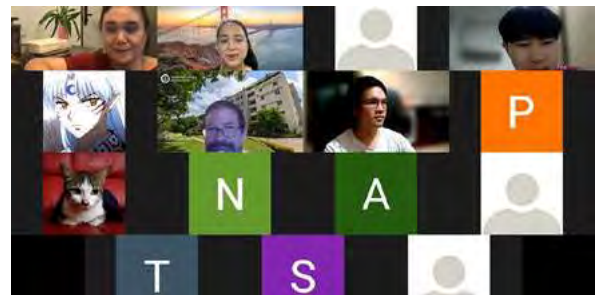


Sharing Childhood Memories

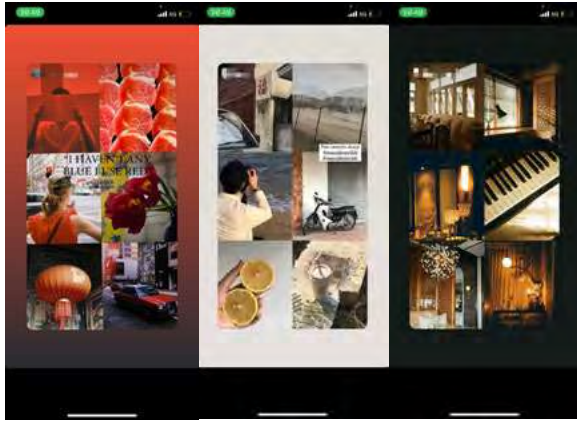
Healthy Meal Photo Contest

MUIC Student Create Murals for New Clinic in Bangkok

A group of first-year students from Mahidol University International College's (MUIC) Communication Design Program, under the guidance of Asst. Prof. Dale Konstanz, instructor in the program and Assistant Dean for Research, recently created murals for the new Pribta Clinic in Bangkok.

The project helped inaugurate collaborations between the Institute for HIV Research and Innovation (IHRI) and Mahidol University who have a memorandum of understanding. The clinic was established by IHRI and provides sexual health services for all groups, but specializes in working with younger generations and specific demographics, including the transgender community. The students who designed the murals chose the theme of "Wonderland" as it is intended to help create a fun and relaxed atmosphere in the clinic. The artwork is composed of illustrations featuring a lively universe filled with characters inspired by viruses and bacteria tested and treated at the clinic. In the process of developing the murals, the students learned about sexually transmitted diseases at the clinic and then conducted visual research and found additional information to add to knowledge to create the work. This project is yet another way that MUIC continues to bridge the gap between science and art, one of the goals set out by Assoc. Prof. Chulathida Chomchai, M.D., Dean of MUIC.



Promoting Environmental Conservation

Based on the mission to support and promote hill tribe youth to have an opportunity to study the Buddha’s dharma, the school provides free education and aims to produce students with knowledge, abilities, morality, ethics, commitment to a good quality of life with the hope that they will continue to practice Buddhism and be a role model to people in the highlands.

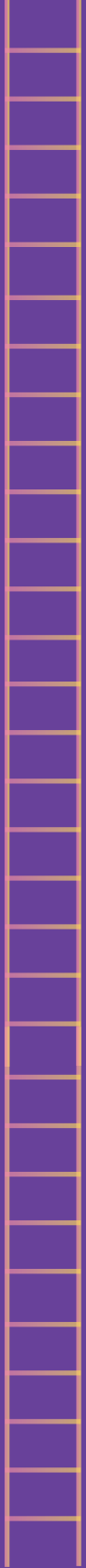
