
## A CREATIVE, INNOVATIVE AND HARMONIOUS MUIC




## NUMBER OF FULL-TIME STUDENTS

### Master's Degree






### Percentage of Undergraduate Students Who Graduate Within 4 Years

## AUN-QA ACCREDITATION FOR MEDIA AND COMMUNICATION PROGRAM AT ASEAN LEVEL

The Media and Communication Program at Mahidol University International College (MUIC) achieved a significant milestone by completing the 373rd ASEAN University Network-Quality Assurance (AUN-QA 4.0) assessment from January 29 to 31, 2024. This evaluation, conducted at the International Program level, was hosted on-site at the MUIC Salaya campus.

The assessment was led by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Tan Kay Chuan, Chief Assessor, and Prof. Dr. Sok Uttara. The team engaged with various stakeholders to ensure a comprehensive evaluation. Key discussions involved Prof. Chulathida Chomchai, M.D., MUIC Dean, and the Self-Assessment Report (SAR) team members, including Asst. Prof. Dr. Wankwan Polachan, Dr. Nunnapan Puathanawat, and Dr. Supathida Kulvaparopas. These conversations provided invaluable insights into the college's academic landscape and its offerings to both students and faculty.

During the assessment, the team conducted interviews with academic staff, support staff, students, alumni, and employers. They also toured the program's facilities to gain firsthand knowledge of the resources available to students.

The successful completion of the AUN-QA 4.0 assessment highlights the program's commitment to academic excellence and continuous improvement. It reflects the dedication of the faculty, staff, and stakeholders in shaping the program's dynamic academic experience.





In celebration of its 37th anniversary, Mahidol University International College (MUIC) organized a series of special events on March 23-24, 2023. The festivities commenced with an opening ceremony on March 23, 2023, at the Screening Room A556, Aditayathorn Building, MUIC, where Prof. Banchong Mahaisavariya, M.D., President of Mahidol University, delivered the opening remarks. On the morning of March 24, the Dean, executives, faculty members, and staff participated in the Offering of Blessing Ritual at the Chao Por Khuntoong Shrine, followed by a Religious Ceremony. 
## **MUIC CELEBRATES 37TH ANNIVERSARY**


MUIC Students Win Multiple Awards at The Ajinomoto Young Chef Thailand Project


