






December 14th 2020:

Indoor PM 2.5 = 7-17




- Many staff have children that have to study online at home.





Health and safety concerns




Increased visa cost for entering Thailand

Solutions:


- Offering competitively priced exchange/visiting experience that caters to wide areas of study

Competing commercial language institutions




Solution: increase the visibility of PC and transform it into a stand-alone center for language training for all learners




