Any applications received after this deadline will be ineligible for the competition.

The full applications will be assessed by a research review committee which will score and rank applications based on quality of the proposal. Funds will be allocated to proposals considered to be in the fundable range starting at the highest ranking until available funding of each proposal call is exhausted. The decisions of the RPM Section will be final.
