



Announcement of Mahidol University International College
on Criteria for Support of Counterpart Fund for Research Categorized
as Project Funded by External Sources
B.E.2563 (A.D. 2020)

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Whereas it is deemed appropriate to revise the Announcement of Mahidol University International College on Criteria for Support of Counterpart Fund for Research Categorized as Project Funded by External Sources in order to comply with the policy on encouraging lecturers to increasingly request for research funds from external sources.

By the virtue of Item 10(6) and Item 18 of the Regulations of Mahidol University on the Administration of International College, College of Management and College of Music B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010) and the Amendment Version, Item 22 and Item 23 of the Announcement of Mahidol University on Criteria and Methods of Receiving Money, Keeping Money, Reimbursing Money, Paying Money and Controlling Money Payments B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008) and the resolutions from the Faculty Committee of Mahidol University International College (MUIC) in the meeting no. 6/2562 on 10th June B.E. 2562 (A.D. 2019) and no. 9/2562 on 11th August B.E. 2563 (A.D. 2020), MUIC has stipulated the Criteria for Support of Counterpart Fund for Research Categorized as Project Funded by External Sources B.E. 2563 (A.D. 2020) detailed as follows.

1. Repeal the Announcement of Mahidol University International College on Criteria for Support of Counterpart Fund for Research Categorized as Project Funded by External Sources B.E.2556 (A.D. 2013) signed on 14th January B.E. 2556 (A.D. 2013)

2. Qualifications of Applicants for support of Counterpart Fund for Research

2.1 Being an academic staff performing position of professor, associate professor, assistant professor, lecturer or a supporting staff performing position of assistant lecturer at Mahidol University International College with the time of performance at the College from 1 year on, having full-time actual works at the College without being on education leave

2.2 Being the Head of Research Project

2.3 Being not a person of pending report submission of the research funded by the income of the College or of Mahidol University or by money from other sources

2.4 During the period of receiving counterpart fund, the applicant shall not receive any counterpart fund from other sources and if it is necessary to receive additional counterpart fund from other sources, the applicant must demonstrate clear reasons that such fund receiving is an add-on to enhance the proficiency of the project. However, the budget category must not be overlapping.

2.5 Being a person having published with international academic journals listed in the database specified by Gor Por Aor and/or having academic works that can be submitted to request for academic position according to the Regulations of Mahidol University on Academic Position B.E. 2561 (A.D. 2018) and have at least “Good” quality level according to the Announcement of Mahidol University on Definition, Format, Publication and Quality Level of Academic Works B.E. 2562 (A.D. 2019) at least two works during the last 5 years. Such person must be the first named author or the principal author taking part no less than 50% of the work or the corresponding author of at least 1 work. However, both published works must not be the dissertation of the applicant.

3. The research project applied for the support must comprise the entire qualifications as follows:

3.1 A research project receiving funding from external sources, including the research project receiving funding from Mahidol University.

3.2 A a new research project which has never received support of counterpart fund from Mahidol University International College.

3.3 A a research project which is able to produce the research outcome to be published in international journals having the impact factor, and/or to be published in the international journals having peer review, or to be published in the international academic journals listed in the database specified by Gor Por Aor or being registered for a patent or being an academic work that can be submitted to request for academic position according to the Regulations of Mahidol University on Academic Position B.E. 2561 (A.D. 2018) and have at least “Good” quality level according to the Announcement of Mahidol University on Definition, Format, Publication and Quality Level of Academic Works B.E. 2562 (A.D. 2019).

/3.4 For a research...

3.4 For a research project which is a research study and experiment on human beings or animals, a prior approval from the human research ethic committee must be acquired.

4. Criteria and Ratio of the Support of Counterpart Fund

4.1 The College will make a support of counterpart fund of not more than 30 percent of the received research funds or not more than 500,000 Baht (Five hundred thousand baht).

4.2 The College will hold back 20 percent of the counterpart fund and the grantee will regain the 20 percent held back by the College upon submission of documentary evidence demonstrating that the research is published in international journals having the impact factor and/or published in the international journal having strong peer review, or is published in the international academic journals listed in the database specified by Gor Por Aor or is registered for a patent or is an academic work that can be submitted to request for academic position according to the Regulations of Mahidol University on Academic Position B.E. 2561 (A.D. 2018) and have at least “Good” quality level according to the Announcement of Mahidol University on Definition, Format, Publication and Quality Level of Academic Works B.E. 2562 (A.D. 2019).

5. Documents to be submitted for request of counterpart fund for research

5.1 Application Form requesting for support of counterpart fund for research.

5.2 Research Project being funded by the specified source.

5.3 Document confirming the support from the specified source.

5.4 Profile of the applicant applying for the support of counterpart fund.

6. Conditions of Receiving the Support of Counterpart Fund for Research

6.1 The grantee must submit a progress report of the research project at the time specified in the fund receiving agreement.

6.2 The grantee must have at least one published article according to Item 3.3 within 2 years after receiving the funding. If there is no such publishing, a letter clarifying the reason must be submitted to the Dean of the International College.

6.3 The complete research report and its Thai/English abstracts or all published research in all formats, all patterns must entitle “Mahidol University International College” as the publishing address.

7. In case where the grantee fails to submit the progress report according to Item 6.1 or there is misconduct in any clauses hereto, the International College reserves the rights to make the funding payment.

8. In case where the request for the funding is not in compliance with the criteria prescribed by the College, the Research Committee shall be the considerator.

9. In case of problems arising out of this announcement, the Dean shall be the adjudicator and the decision of the Dean shall be final.

This announcement shall be effective from 1st October B.E. 2563 (A.D. 2020)
